

Instructions for Oral Presenters

- All presenters are requested to use their own laptop for their presentation.
- We recommend using widescreen (16:9) for your presentation to ensure proper display. Standard (4:3) is also acceptable, but the content may appear smaller on the screen.

Please be prepared with the following items

- Your own laptop
- Power adapter / battery
- HDMI adapter (if your device requires one)

Before your presentation begins

- Connect your device to the projector using an HDMI cable.
- Share your presentation file on screen at the start of your talk.
- Please use your computer's highlighter tool instead of a laser pointer.

If you experience any connection issues, please contact the staff in the hall for assistance.

Instructions for Poster Presenters

- The exhibition area is in the lounge next to the Main Hall.
- The space will be accessible until the beginning of the final session on **September 19th**.
- Posters may be set up starting at **12:00 on September 18th** and must be removed by **10:00 on September 19th**.
- Poster presenters are requested to stand by their posters during the **Poster Session (17:10–18:40 on September 18th)** to interact with attendees.

Poster Guidelines

- Each presenter will be provided with a **poster board** measuring **120 cm (height) × 90 cm (width)**.
- Poster number tags and **magnets** will be available at the venue.
- Posters can remain on display from **12:00 on September 18th** until the **last coffee break on September 19th**.
- **Please note:** Any posters remaining after **11:00 on September 19th** will be discarded by the organizers.
